

Protect Yourself Against H1N1 – Get Vaccinated

Public health clinics start this weekend!

What: The Pennsylvania Department of Health will offer H1N1 flu vaccine free of charge to Pennsylvanians in the recommended target groups.

Who: Only individuals in the following recommended target groups can get vaccinated at this time:

- individuals between the ages of six months and 24 years;
- household contacts and caregivers for children younger than six months;
- pregnant women;
- healthcare providers and emergency medical services personnel; and
- those under 65 years of age with underlying health conditions, including asthma, diabetes, suppressed immune systems, heart disease, kidney disease, and neurocognitive and neuromuscular disorders.

When: November 20, 21, and 22

Where: Vaccine will be available in 18 sites across the state. Please register to find the location closest to you.

How: You must [schedule](#) an appointment time, day and location prior to the public health clinic dates.
